



IMPORTANT TEMPORARY RULES FOR DUNHEVED GOLF CLUB EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

The following conditions have been implemented as part of our response to the current COVID-19 Public Health Order. Golfers should exhibit a heightened awareness of personal hygiene and adhere to [social distancing guidelines](#) at all times.

ARRIVAL TO DGC

Please ensure that you arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to your booked tee time.

QR CODE SCANNING

Please ensure you scan in via our QR Code on arrival to the Golf Shop and/or practice facilities. Please ensure you validate this by showing staff the green check in tick. Don't forget to check out once you leave following your round.

MASKS

Masks are mandatory indoors and must be worn at all times.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Members MUST maintain a distance of 1.5 metres at all times. DO NOT congregate out the front of the Golf Shop or in the Carpark and proceed to your car following your round.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

The practice facilities are open for warm up purposes only. Please do not congregate and at all times observe Social Distancing and Public Gathering requirements.

- **RANGE** – A maximum of 10 people on the range at any one time is permitted.
- **PRACTICE NETS** – A maximum of 1 person in each net at any one time is permitted.
- **PUTTING GREEN** – A maximum of 8 persons on the putting green at any one time is permitted.

GOLF CARTS – WEAR A MASK

2 persons are currently permitted to ride in each cart. However, when sharing a cart players must wear a mask as they are unable to social distance. One player must be responsible for the driving duties for the entire round and the passenger remains on the passenger's side of the cart for the entire round.

BUNKERS

All rakes have been removed. Bunkers will remain in play. Preferred lie may be taken within bunker 30cm. At completion of bunker play, players are to smooth bunkers surface as best as possible with foot.

HOLE & FLAG STICKS

Flagsticks must remain in the hole at all times and be untouched. A pool noodle will be used to make the hole shallower than normal for ease of removing the ball without touching the flagstick or cup. The ball must be holed.

SCORECARDS

All players are to mark and sign their own score card and to verbally agree their total scores at the end of the round with their playing partner. We suggest marking your playing partners score in the marker column on your card. Remember honesty and integrity is integral to golf. Players to place their score cards in the score card box outside of the Golf Shop and scores will be entered by Staff.

NTP

There will be no NTP's.

BUBBLERS & BALL WASHERS

These will be covered over and not available for use. Please ensure you bring sufficient water, or purchase from the Golf Shop before you go out or at half way.

BOOKING IN - ESSENTIAL

Booking in for Competitions and Social Play will take place via the Online Booking In or by contacting the Golf Shop on 9623 0239. Timesheets will be released as per current practice each Friday night @ 6.00pm for 2 weeks in advance.

PACE OF PLAY

Pace of play is critical to ensure we keep moving to avoid any congestion. Ready Golf is encouraged at all times.

These conditions may continue to change with short notice as we are guided by recommendations of our governing bodies and directives of the government and state health authorities.

Please play your part and do the right thing. Check in every time, wear your mask when required and adhere to staff requests, social distancing and public gathering laws at all times.
